During this two-day workshop, attendees will:


- Advance their proficiency in NUCCA biomechanics and adjusting

The history of our wonderful organization that started with Dr. Gregory has had in its core tenants the principle that human potential is best expressed when the Atlas Subluxation Complex is reduced to its maximum capacity. The Certification Process has been an extension of the commitment by the organization to produce this for over 35 years. In the desire of your Board of Directors to perpetuate the creation of more doctors better able to deal with the intricacies of the ASC, this past fall a motion was passed to suspend the fees associated with Part 1 of the Board Certification Process. For the next year a doctor has the capacity to be mentored through the First part of the Board Certification Process without the fees traditionally associated with it. This "experimental trial" has been

adopted for the purpose of furthering engagement in the Certification Process. At the end of the year, the results will be evaluated and further determination of the "trial" will be contemplated.

We sincerely hope our membership is encouraged to take advantage of this wonderful opportunity. We would love to see a large percentage of our doctors accomplishing Board Certification, not only for the benefit of the doctors personal growth and development, but more importantly for the health of the people impacted by each doctor.
